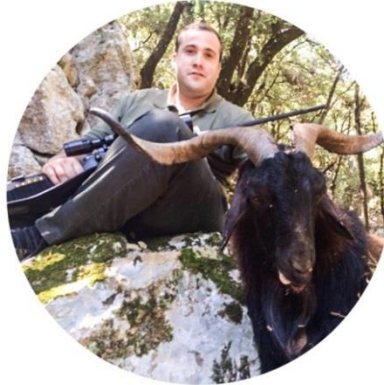




BALEAREAN BUCK

Hunting season: all year over



Hunting area and information:

The habitat of the Balearian buck is the island of Mallorca and the hunting area with more than 2000 hectares is in the north of Palma in the Sierra de Tramuntana in a maximum altitude of 1000 m. Hunting season is all year over but best time is April – middle of June (rut season) und October + November.

The average trophy size is a length of 62 cm. The hide cape of the buck is red and black. This hunt can be done in a combination of Hybrid Ibex hunt or fishing.

Program:

- 1. day: Arrival in Palma – Pick up service and assistance with gun import
Transfer to the hotel (ask for hotel list)
- 2 + 3. Tag: Hunt on Balearian buck
- 5. Tag: Airport Transfer
